- Review technology needs for the school presentation by Katie Hopkins,
 School tech specialist. (15 min)
 - -add link to Katies presentation in agenda minutes
 - -Computer Refresh- program to provide teacher/student computers and routine equipment updates
 - -Estimated total cost of tech in classroom- 20,436\$/classroom over 5 years, district covers slightly less than ½ of tech costs, school responsible for 10,763\$/classroom over 5 years, Holbrook has 23-26 classrooms, approx.

260,000\$ every 5 years (school cost about 20,000\$ annually for tech expenses)

- -this year we are utilizing CARES money for updating Apple TV's and ipads
 -district tech plan as well as school plan, 5 year rotating plan to replace tech
 equipment in ongoing basis
- -Tech Trek, way to fund school portion of tech expenses for last several years (highest year was around 10K, last year much less due to smaller event due to covid), ask PTA to re-evaluate if we can do Tech Trek in the spring
- -Can consider utilizing trustlands funds to supplement for technology costs
- 3. Continue discussion on digital citizenship programs. Mrs. Chidester to report teachers' preference on current programs. (10 min)
 -teachers are interested in digital literacy program, current program offered

by state/district is viable option, students continue to get digital citizenship lesson at beginning of year in computer class, have asked computer teacher to spend time at beginning of each class about one digital citizenship topic, some individual teachers are also doing some modules on digital citizenship consider piloting some programs in classrooms this year prior to adopting school wide program for next year

- -can consider trustlands funds to purchase digital citizenship program
 -phone policy sent out to parents in weekly update this week (phones not
 to be used during classroom hours, phones from home do not have same
 filters on them as school equipment
- 4. Continue discussion on positive behavior plan. Mrs. Chidester report progress of new program in her classroom. (7-10 min)
 - -HOUSE system (Ron Clark Academy), working well in classrooms that are doing it, kids really seem to be loving it
 - -consider doing school-wide in future
